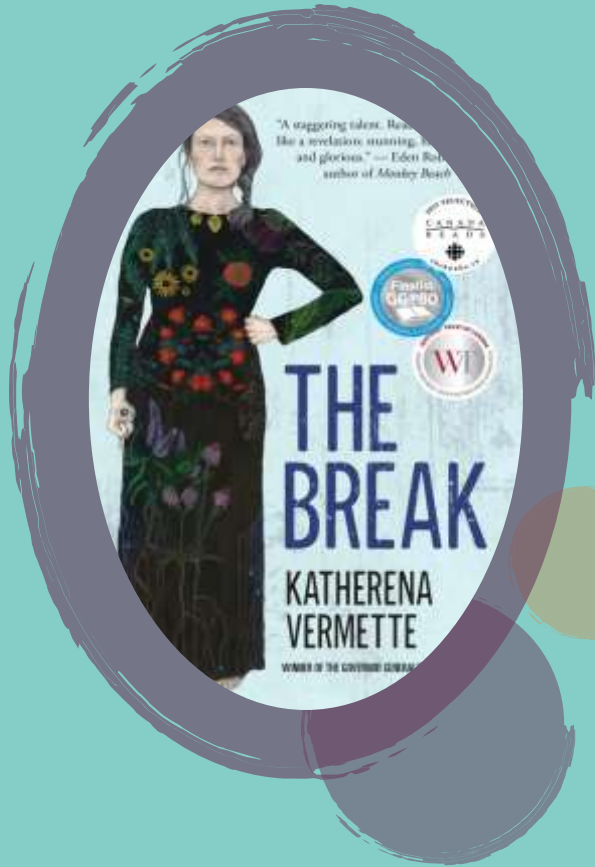


# *Participate in a Book Discussion:*
